LASSO LOVE BARS

Jessie may be the roughest, toughest cowgirl, but she has a soft side. She shares it with her best pals, Bullseye, Woody, Buzz—and YOU! Her **Lasso Love Bar** combines her lassoing tricks with notes of lavender for a lovely lather.

TIP

To make soaps with swirls of secondary colors from the color wheel (p. 6), add two colors to the clear base instead of one!

YOU'LL NEED:

GLYCERIN SOAP BASE

1 cube (50 grams), cut in half

LAVENDER ESSENTIAL OIL (OPTIONAL)

1/8 teaspoon (.62 mL)



RED GLYCERIN

6 small chips



BLUE GLYCERIN

6 small chips



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Lightly oil the molds and wipe out any excess oil.
2. Cut the cube of soap (50g) base in half.
3. In two microwave-safe cups, melt 25g soap base and red chips together and 25g soap base and blue chips in the other cup.
4. Microwave at 5-second intervals until both colors are completely melted.
5. Pour both melted soaps side by side into a single mold.
6. Using a toothpick, gently stir the melted soaps in a figure-eight "lassoing" motion.
7. Repeat steps 6 and 7 in the next molds until you run out of glycerin.
8. Cool soaps at room temperature for at least 45 minutes.
9. Gift finished soap to whomever lassoes your heart!



TIP

Be careful not to stir too hard or you'll blend the colors together instead of swirl them!
